## **JUNIOR DAIRY ANIMAL REGISTRATION POLICY REMINDER FOR 2012 WISCONSIN STATE FAIR**

West Allis, WI – November 29, 2011 – Officials at Wisconsin State Fair, presented by U.S. Cellular, are issuing a reminder for Junior Dairy exhibitors planning on showing at the 2012 Fair. The 2012 Fair will take place Thursday, August 2 through Sunday, August 12 at Wisconsin State Fair Park in West Allis.

All animals in the Junior Dairy Department two years or older must be registered or transferred on/or before January 1st of the Fair year in the name of the exhibitor. Updated for 2012: Co-ownership will be allowed as long as the exhibitor's full name appears on the registration paper along with any other individual under 21 years of age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Breed association lease programs do not meet Wisconsin State Fair ownership requirements.
